At the close of module 2 of EASUN's FOLD (Facilitating Organizational Learning and Development) training, held from August 26-30, 2024, the facilitators were deeply moved by participants' stories of how they were reshaping structures and processes within their organizations, even as they grappled with new concepts. At this early stage in the training, they imagined, such growth was probably driven by a transformative sense of hope--which fuelled optimism, openness to learning, and belief that success was attainable. One facilitator noted, expressing profound humility, that this transformation reflects the ongoing redemptive work of God in humanity.
